Position Summary: The Distribution System Operator is responsible for operation and maintenance of the water distribution system. - Installs pipe, valves, hydrants, and other fittings usual to laying pipe lines
- Installs and repairs water lines
- Performs maintenance on pumping stations, water storage facilities and the water distribution system, which includes participation in the flushing program
- Repairs sewer lines as required
- Inspects, supervises, and assists installations by outside contractors as needed
- Removes, installs, maintains, reads, and occasionally assists in testing meters
- Performs equipment, road, yard, and building maintenance
